

## HKIE Adjudication Training Course 2019

June/July 2019

### Introduction

The proposed Security of Payment Legislation (SOPL) provides for nomination of adjudicators from an Adjudicator Nominating Body (ANB) named in the contract. The Institution is in the process of establishing a Panel of Adjudicators for SOP Adjudication. Key Criteria for listing in the panel include completion of an approved Adjudication Training Course and passing the written examination.

### The Adjudication Training Course

The course will be delivered over 10 sessions of 3 hours each (usually two evenings per week on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, from 6:30pm to 9:30pm) in June/July 2019 at the HKIE HQs, to be followed by a 3-hour written examination in July/August 2019. An update session may be arranged after the finalisation of the proposed legislation.

**Course Fee:** \$8,000 per person including course materials, examination fee, coffee/tea and refreshment

**Course Material:** Powerpoint presentations and handouts will be in English, while verbal explanation may either be in English or Cantonese to suit the participants.

The number of places is limited to 30. Applicants should be Corporate Members of HKIE with sufficient experience in contract administration and/or dispute resolution related to construction industry in Hong Kong. Applications will be processed with due consideration on the applicants' qualifications and experience.
