Digital Twin Seminar & Tour –

- Understand there are different Common BIM Viewer Software (Free/charged)
- Understand basic BIM workflow and standardisation of data
- Open a BIM model
- Navigate, select items and find information within a BIM model
- Cut section within a BIM model
- Measure dimensions within a BIM model
- Mark comments within a BIM model

*The quiz after the BIM Viewer training is not mandatory. Participants who successfully get a minimum scope of 60% (12 out of the 20 questions of multiple choices) will obtain a BIM Viewer Certificate issued by CIC.
