## **Green Technology Opportunities amidst the Plastic and Waste Problem during the Pandemic**

### **Programme Highlights**

In consequence of COVID-19 pandemic, the massive increase in plastic and waste loading resulted by the tightened preventive measures and the rising medical demand respectively raise the public concern over the waste disposal and recycling management in Hong Kong.

In this online talk, Dr Yau will delineate various approach of green technology for the waste treatment in terms of transportation and local treatment, collection and separation methodology, recycling process and facilities, and public education in order to explore the emerging opportunities in green technology development during the pandemic.



### **About the Speaker**

With over 25 years of experience in environmental science and related industry, Dr Yau established an energy saving company in 1995 and an Environmental Association in 1997. He has been working on the frontline of environmental affairs and created impact on pilot work and policy advocacy including:

- Smart Countryside initiatives, now part of ITB policy.
- Solar Energy – New guideline and flexibility implement by the government (2018)
- New Agriculture Policy – Accepted and included in the Policy Address 2016 (Agriculture Park and \$500M Agriculture Fund).
- Fung Yuen Butterfly Reserve Pilot Project - advocate Environment Bureau's New Nature Conservation Policy (2005)
- Energy Saving pilot project - Pilot and advocate Environment Bureau's Energy conservation Fund (2010)

He has also been actively involved in advisory boards of the HKSAR government, including the Hong Kong Town Planning Board, Advisory Council on the Environment, Ping Wo Fund Chairman, Sustainable Fisheries Development Fund Chairman, City Innovation and Technology (I&T) Grand Challenge Advisory Committee, Country and Marine Park Board, and HK Geopark Task Group.
