Speaker:	<p>Ir Prof Wilson S K TSANG</p> <p>Wilson graduated from the Hong Kong Polytechnic in year 1980 and pursue further studies in UK with a MSc in Building Services Engineering and a MSc in Management and he also graduated from The University of Hong Kong with a Master of Laws degree.</p> <p>Wilson is now teaching in the Hong Kong Polytechnic University in a capacity of Professor of Practice on the subjects of Fire Safety Engineering and Construction Management and Law. Past Chairman of The “Hong Kong Institution of Engineers” Fire Division in 2016/17. He is also currently an advisory member of the Hong Kong Fire Services Department Fire Safety Standards Advisory Group in formulating new standards, regulations and requirements in the Hong Kong Fire Industry, and a member of the Appeal Tribunal Panel, Building Ordinance (Cap 123). He is also a Mediator, Arbitrator, Adjudicator and Expert Witness.</p> <p>Wilson used to work in the Airport Authority as a Principal Manager and has his career spanning over 30 years experience in Hong Kong major infrastructure projects including the Hong Kong Chek Lap Kok Airport Development in the field of the Building Services installation and fire engineering design for Terminals, AsiaWorld Expo, railway (Automated People Mover) tunnels, baggage tunnels and road tunnels etc.</p>
Highlights:	<p>Fire can occur unexpectedly and pose a serious threat to lives and property. Understanding and implementing fire safety measures is essential for ensuring the protection of individuals and communities.</p> <p>Identifying potential fire hazards within buildings. Common sources of fires include faulty electrical systems and cooking equipment. The importance of having effective fire protective measures and the proper response in the event of a fire. This includes knowing how to use fire extinguishers, understanding evacuation routes, and participating in regular fire drills.</p>

	Familiarity with these procedures can protect our lives and properties from the devastating effects of fire.
