**Views on Proposal on Inclusion of New Products under Third Phase of  
Mandatory Energy Efficiency Labelling Scheme (MEELS)**

Thank you for your email of 17 March 2015 inviting the Institution for views on the captioned subject.

The Institution in general agrees to the proposal on Inclusion of New Products under the Third Phase of Mandatory Energy Efficiency Labelling Scheme (MEELS). Particularly, we would like to suggest adding in the proposal with **domestic electric kettles** (ranging from 2.2 liter to 4.0 liter) which are commonly found in Hong Kong domestic households. We have concern that users always keep the power sockets connected to the domestic electric kettles for maintaining the water temperature after boiling. Continuous power consumption results as the insulation of electric kettles are not 100% guarantee. They will restart heating water to the pre-set temperature.
