He will share project experience and how to add more value to customers using real cases. Mr Peter FUNG is the Former Chairman of Hong Kong Society for Quality. He is also the Certified Quality Engineer (CQE) and Certified Six Sigma Black Belt (CSSBB) of American Society for Quality.

With the aim to optimise spatial efficiency and innovative solution, Automated Parking System (APS) is one of the better solutions to provide more parking lots in limited spaces.
