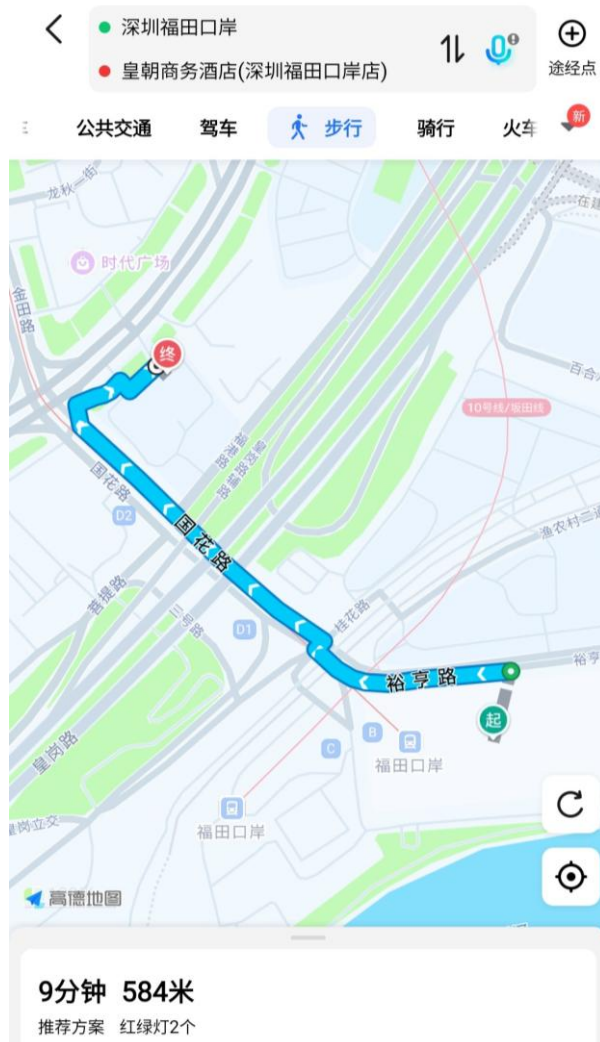

Note: For members who registered for your guest(s) without providing their email during registration, please forward this email and advise your guest(s) to join the WhatsApp Group.

Registration/ Starter: The participants will be divided into two divisions according to their handicap claimed. Generally, those with the lower handicap indices will be grouped in Division A and those with the higher handicap indices will be grouped into Division B.

Starter Tee: For Division A - Men: Blue tees; Ladies: Red tees
For Division B - Men: White tees Ladies: Red tees

Competition: 18 holes, New New Peoria
Prizes include:
Overall
i) Gross Score Champion
For Each Division
ii) Net Score Champion, 1st Runner-up and 2nd Runner-up
iii) Individual Nearest to Pin at selected Par 3 holes
iv) Individual Longest Drive at selected holes

Competition Rules: Guests and first time HKIEGS players are welcome to play but only eligible for the nearest-to-pin prizes.

When there is a tie, the player of higher handicap will win. In the case of a tie within a division and the players are assigned the same handicap, the winner will be determined on the basis of the gross scores for the last nine holes (i.e. the method of matching score cards according to R & A Rules). If the tying players have the same gross score for the last nine holes, the winner will be determined on the basis of the last six holes, the last three holes and finally the 18th hole, 17th hole, 16th hole and so on.

For the nearest-to-pin prizes, the ball position after the first tee-shot must be on the green. For the longest drive prizes, the ball position after the first tee shot must be on the fairway.

In the best interest of time, gimmie is allowed if distance is less than the rod length of a standard putter. Play ready golf, i.e. whoever is ready, hit first!

Always keep up with the group in front. If your group cannot keep up with the group in front, the captain should control the speed of play by all possible means such as by only allowing one practice stroke, stopping players to continue after 3/4/5 over for a particular hole (i.e. double par), forcing ready golf etc. If your group is too slow and forced by the Club Marshall to skip a hole, the whole group would have the score of double par for that hole.

If a ball is lost in water or other hazard (yellow or red stakes), the player may, under the penalty of one stroke, drop a ball near the margin of the hazard. However, there must be reasonable evidence that the ball lodged in the hazard. If available, Drop Zone must be used. For ball lost and out of bound, use drop zone or drop the ball at the point of penalty with a penalty of one stroke.

For rules not mentioned in the above, follow the Local Course Rules. For rules not mentioned in the Local Course Rules, follow R & A Rules.

If there is any doubt, the HKIEGS Playing Committees decision will be final.

Score: Flight leader (1st player at each flight) will be responsible for marking the scores for the flight. Please enter the gross number of strokes for each hole, i.e. 5, 6, 7 etc., not +1, +2, and "Double Par" is the maximum for each hole. Marker and All Players should sign the card after confirming the marked score, and hand it to the person in charge of scores immediately after the round.

Dinner/Prize Presentation: **Prize presentation and dinner** to be followed at 唐宴海鮮酒家 at around **6:00 pm**. The coach will return to Futian Checkpoint (福田口岸) at around **9:00 pm**.

Weather: Unless typhoon signal no. 8 or the black rainstorm warning is hoisted by 6:00a.m., please assume that the event will proceed.
